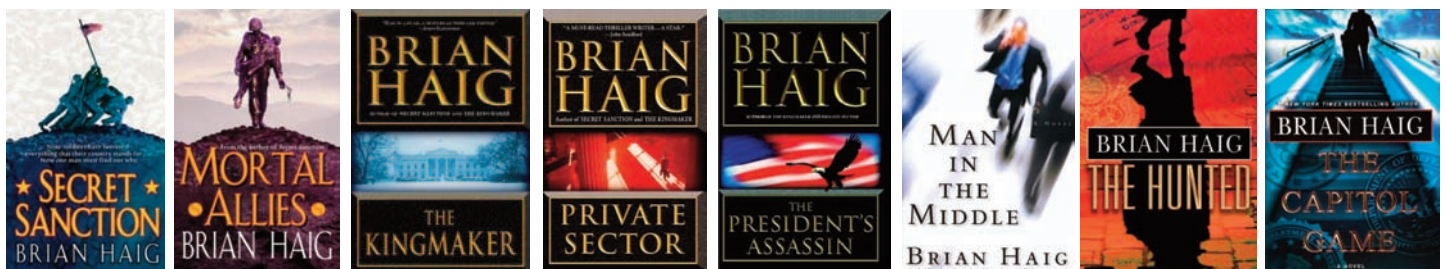

Brian Haig spent 22 years on active duty before retiring as a lieutenant colonel in 1997 and going into private business. Served as global strategist on the Army staff; Special Assistant to the Commander-in-Chief of the United Nations Command and Combined Forces Command, the commander of all American and Republic of Korea forces in Korea. Also Special Assistant to the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, preparing all speeches, briefings, public statements, congressional testimonies, and advising the Chairman on strategic, global, and Asian regional issues.

Haig now writes full-time. His first novel, *Secret Sanction*, was a national and Washington Post bestseller, optioned by actor Nicholas Cage and his production company for a future motion picture.

Additional novels: *Mortal Allies*, *The Kingmaker*, *Private Sector*, *The Hunted*, and *The Capitol Game*.

Haig has a Bachelor of Science from the United States Military Academy, a Master's in Public Administration from Harvard University, and a Master's in Government from Georgetown University. His military awards include Airborne wings and the Ranger tab, two Legions of Merit, and the Distinguished Service Medal.
